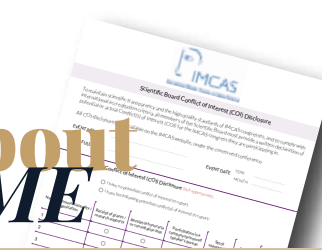

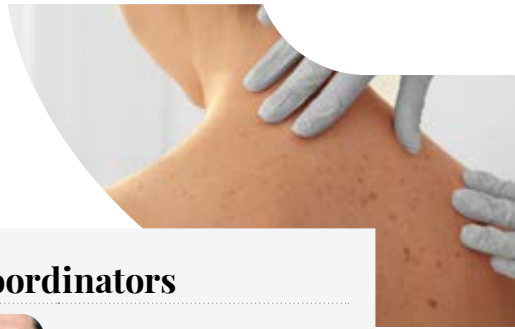

An educational grant is a financial donation with no exchange partnership at stake. Unlike sponsorship, which is characterized by a bilateral exchange implying that the receiver promotes the sponsor, the grant is a unilateral gesture. Funds are given by the donor to support a project or program. The scientific content is entirely developed and chosen by the Scientific Committee and is therefore eligible for CME Accreditation.

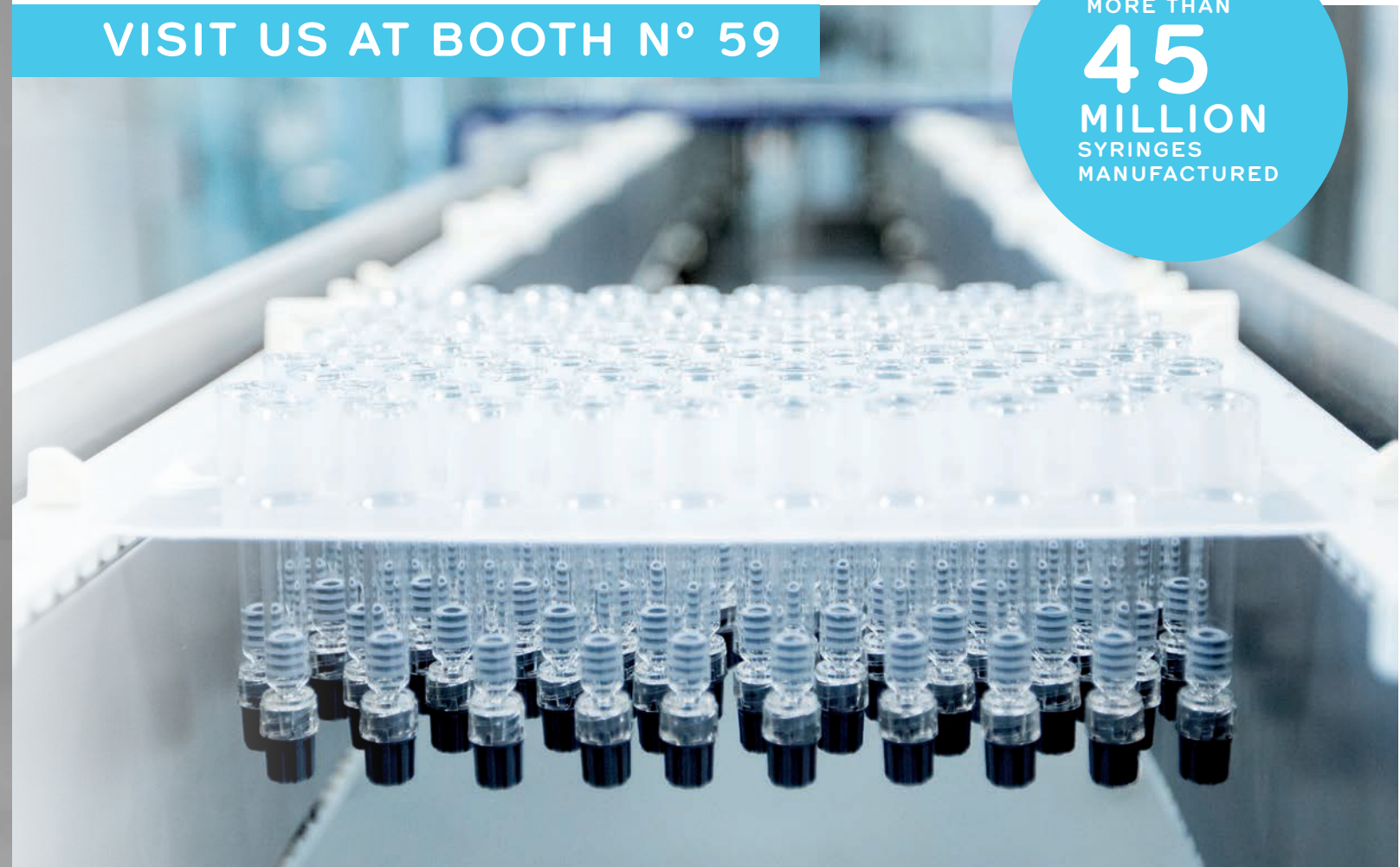

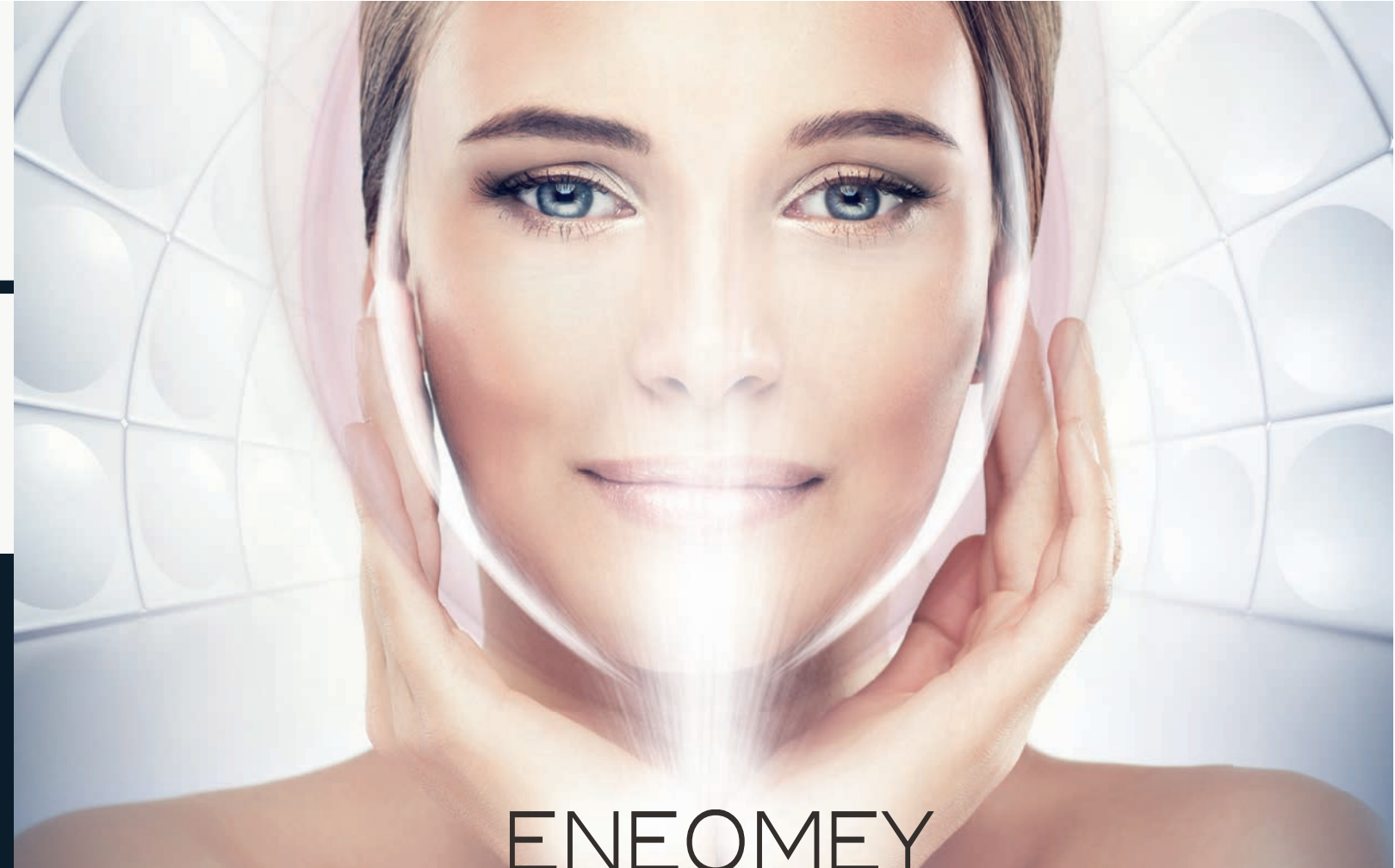
